At this meeting we watched a video presentation on the Journey to Belonging: Choice and Inclusion, presented by MCCSS (Ministry of Children Community and Social Services), on September 29, 2023.

This video explained the rise of Journey to Belonging and the gradual acceptance as it stands today. Although interesting to watch, we all realized that this subject is still many years away from being implemented. However, that shouldn't stop us from being prepared where our loved ones are concerned.

Wendy passed out the Person-Directed Home Living Options Handbook for Individuals, Their Families & Support Network Teams to each of us. As you can see by the attached Table of Contents, this Handbook covers all areas necessary to create an Individualized Plan for our loved one. Completing this will give us all a sense of control and ease should anything happen to us.
