- Monitor and provide personal support and assistance in activities of daily living which are appropriate to the needs to all people supported by the organization; which includes providing personal care (personal hygiene, etc.) with dignity and respect.

- Participate in assessment process, collect and record behavioural data, implement behavioural treatment plans and protocols established by the multidisciplinary treatment team;

- Participate in community assessments and community-based treatment throughout Central East Region when needed;
